

How-to follow up at home

Your child will benefit even more if you can reinforce the training in a few simple ways:

- If your child is struggling with a problem, ask them to imagine someone who thinks differently from them. Then have them imagine what advice that person would give to help solve the problem.
- Remind your child that there are many good ways to solve problems. You can't predict in advance whether an idea is good; you have to try it.
- Finally, reinforce to your child that they can solve any problem. The key is to keep using the tools they've learned in camp—and to never, never, never give up on themselves.
